City of Johannesburg

Slow but steady progress is being made with City of Johannesburg. The primary drive is to set up permanent O courses in the city's parks beginning with Delta Park in Victory Park, Johannesburg and Dorothy Nyembe Park in Mofolo North, Soweto. There are Environmental Education Centres at both parks and a main drive will be on child education.

We had a meeting with Mavis Mabena and Bongani Mlangeni from City Parks and Nicole Ferguson who is an Environmental Education Specialist based at Rietfontein Nature Reserve. Mavis needed to report back up the chain, so that process will probably be a lengthy one.
