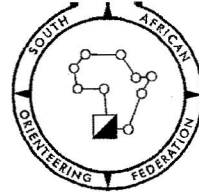

Proposed Amendment to Championship Eligibility Rule

Participation</p> <p data-bbox="285 385 839 601">4.1 Competitors at SA Championships, Gauteng Championships and Western Cape Championships must have been a member of a Member club for at least six months and a SA citizen or a permanent resident of South Africa</p> <p data-bbox="285 646 839 895">4.2 All competitors participate at their own risk. Insurance against accidents shall be the responsibility of competitors themselves. The SA Orienteering Federation and member clubs accept no responsibility for injuries incurred whilst competing in or attending SAOF events.</p>	<p data-bbox="863 317 1222 351">4. Participation and Eligibility</p> <p data-bbox="863 385 1445 532">4.1 Participation at orienteering events is open to all members of the public subject to event specific event notices and the points 4.2 -4.5 below.</p> <p data-bbox="863 646 1445 827">4.2 Participation on the championship courses at the South African National Championships and Provincial Championships is open to paid up members of a Member Club and paid up members of other IOF Member Organizations.</p> <p data-bbox="863 861 1445 1190">4.3 In lieu of point 4.2, all competitors that are South African Citizens or Residents, competing on the championship courses at the above mentioned events, are eligible for trophies and medals. The one exception is visiting (overseas) orienteers or recent arrivals in South Africa (less than three months) who may compete on Championship courses but who are not eligible for trophies/medals.</p> <p data-bbox="863 1224 1445 1519">4.4 In lieu of point 4.2, eligibility for medals and trophies in relay events at South African National Championships and Provincial Championships is subject to all members of a club relay team having been paid up members of that club for at least 6 months. No nationality restrictions apply to members of relay teams.</p> <p data-bbox="863 1553 1445 1780">4.5 All competitors participate at their own risk. Insurance against accidents shall be the responsibility of competitors themselves.
